- Would protect the nation's critical infrastructure and industrial base from cyberattacks.

- Seeks to ensure immigration system puts American workers first.

- Briefly defended the "defund the police" movement in 2020 before speaking against it months later after joining the Biden campaign.
- Supports starting a national registry to keep track of police misconduct, called the National Law Enforcement Accountability Database.

- Vows to undo regulations on pistol braces and roll back Biden's "zero tolerance" policy that revokes federal licenses from firearm dealers who violate gun laws.
- Vows to repeal all Biden administration executive orders on gun owners and manufacturers during his first week of office.

- Says she is "in favor of the Second Amendment" and "in favor of reasonable gun safety laws."
- Has called for a total ban on "assault weapons," a term used to describe some types of semiautomatic rifles, via executive action if Congress does not pass legislation.
- Vows to implement universal background checks for firearm purchases.
- · Supports red flag laws.
- Blames existing gun laws for the rise in school shootings.

Military

- Says he supports achieving "peace through strength" in Europe and the Middle East.
- Calls for building an iron dome missile defense system over the United States.
- Wants to strengthen and modernize the military to make it the "strongest and most powerful in the world."
- Has said the United States' air and space supremacy is essential to ensuring global peace and security.
- Supports the U.S. drone and missile defense system in Israel's defense against Iranian attacks.
- Has defended the Biden administration's decision to leave Afghanistan.

Foreign Affairs & Ukraine, Israel Wars

- Has called for a quick end to the Russia-Ukraine war but has not explicitly endorsed either side in the conflict.
- Calls for using military strength sparingly, and only in clear instances where the United States' national interests are threatened.
- Pledges to support Israel and to seek peace in the Middle East.
- Plans to "rebuild our alliance network in the region to ensure a future of peace, stability, and prosperity."
- Met with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu at Mar-a-Lago on July 26.
- Would ensure NATO allies meet their financial obligations to the organization.
- Would champion the sovereignty and independence of nations in the Indo-Pacific.

- Has said Ukraine losing its war with Russia would mean "all of Europe would be threatened."
- Believes Israel should always be able to defend itself, but "how it does so matters."
- Has said she would "not be silent" about the "tragedies"
 Palestinians in Gaza have faced during the Israel-Hamas war.
- · Supports negotiating a cease-fire deal between Israel and Hamas.
- · Endorses a two-state solution between Israel and Palestine.

CHINA

- · Pledges to secure strategic independence from China.
- Promises to phase out imports of essential goods from the country.
- · Promises to revoke the "most favored nation" status of China.
- Pledges to ban Chinese nationals from buying up American real estate and Industries.
- Proposes tariffs of at least 60 percent on Chinese imports, with potentially higher tariffs on EVs.
- Vows to break up China and Russia's growing alliance.
- Promises to return peace through strength, rebuilding U.S. military and alliances and countering China.

- Vows to prevent unfair trade practices that allow the CCP to undermine American jobs and manufacturing.
- Promises to ensure "America, not China," wins the technology race.
- Agrees with Biden in "responsibly managing" bilateral relations with Beijing, including maintaining open channels of communication.
- Said in 2020 that China's "abysmal human rights record" must be prominently featured in U.S. policy toward the country.
- Opposes Trump's plan to raise tariffs on China and has refrained from commenting on the current administration's continuation of Trump-era tariffs on Chinese goods.
- Supports Taiwan's self-defense against China, in line with the current policy.
